Subject: Local MS Adjustments

Dear Ms. Moore:

The Memphis MPO has determined that the requested Adjustment #02 to the FY 2017-20 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) meets the criteria to be processed as an administrative adjustment and not as an amendment. As a result, there was no public notice of the changes and no vote by the Transportation Policy Board to approve the changes.

The first request is to make changes to 3 projects within the Resurfacing Grouping (MS-LSTP-2014-04):

- 1. McIngvale Road (Hernando) Move \$1,152,400 federal funds for Construction from FY 2017 to FY 2018
- 2. Byhalia Road/Commerce Road West (Hernando) Move \$1,926,880 federal funds for Construction from FY 2017 to FY 2018
- 3. Horn Lake Road (Horn Lake) Move \$100,570 federal funds for PE/ROW from FY 2017 to FY 2018 and \$1,752,786 federal funds for Construction from FY 2018 to FY 2019

The second request is to make changes to 2 projects within the Bike & Pedestrian Grouping (MS-LSTBG-2017-02):

- Johnson Creek Phase II (DeSoto County) Move \$28,000 federal funds for PE from FY 2017 to FY 2018 and combine with the Construction phase. PE phase will be special match credit.
- Snowden Pedestrian Path & Bicycle Project (Southaven) Move \$17,200 federal funds for PE from FY 2018 and combine with FY 2017 and move \$272,800 federal funds for Construction from FY 2019 to FY 2018.

The third request is to make changes to 1 project within the TE/SRTS Grouping (MS-TE-2016-01):

 Johnson Creek Phase I (DeSoto County) – Move \$800,000 federal funds for Construction from FY 2017 to FY 2018. PE phase will be special match credit.

For clarity purposes, the following project names have been updated in the TE/SRTS Grouping and the Bike & Pedestrian Grouping:

- TE/SRTS Grouping: Greenway Trail changed to Johnson Creek Phase I
- Bike & Pedestrian Grouping: Johnson Creek Extension changed to Johnson Creek Phase II

The Memphis MPO has made the requested adjustments to the FY 2017-20 TIP to accurately reflect the requested changes. It is the request of the Memphis MPO that the TIP project changes be amended into the State of Mississippi Statewide Transportation Improvement Plan. Attached to this letter are the old and newly adjusted TIP pages.
