
**TITLE VI ASSURANCE for the  
MEMPHIS URBAN AREA METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION**


The Memphis Urban Area Metropolitan Planning Organization assures that no person shall on the grounds of race, color, national origin, or sex, as provided by Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, and the Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987 (P.I. 100.259) be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or otherwise be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving federal financial assistance from the Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT).

The Memphis Urban Area Metropolitan Planning Organization further assures every effort will be made to ensure nondiscrimination in all of its program and activities, whether those programs or activities were federally funded or not.



The Memphis Urban Area Metropolitan Planning Organization Title VI Coordinator is responsible for initiating and monitoring Title VI activities, preparing required reports and other responsibilities as required by 23 CFR 200 and 49 CFR 21.

As required by the contractual agreement, the Memphis Urban Area Metropolitan Planning Organization will comply with the applicable laws and regulations relative to nondiscrimination in federally or state assisted programs of the Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT).
