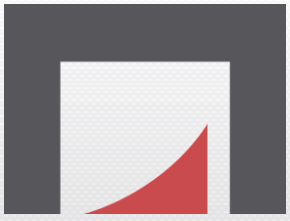

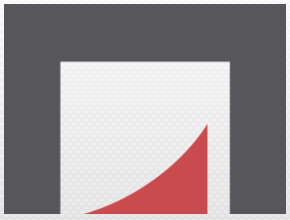

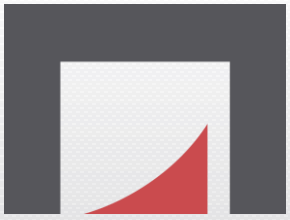

Role of the RTP

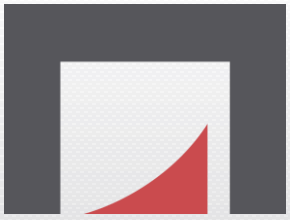
Regional Transportation Plan (RTP)

- Identifies goals, priorities, and projects for all modes
- **A project must be in RTP to receive federal funding**

Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)

- Short-term implementation program showing all funding sources
- Projects move into detailed design and planning
