The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) Mississippi Division and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Region IV Office, in coordination with the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Region IV Office, have reviewed the Air Quality Conformity Determination adopted by the Memphis Urban Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Transportation Policy Board on September 22, 2022.

The Air Quality Conformity Determination covers the DeSoto County, MS maintenance area for the 2008 8-hour ozone National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS) and was conducted to amend the 2050 RTP and adopt the FY 2023-2026 TIP for the Mississippi portion of the MPO.
