## Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) - Background

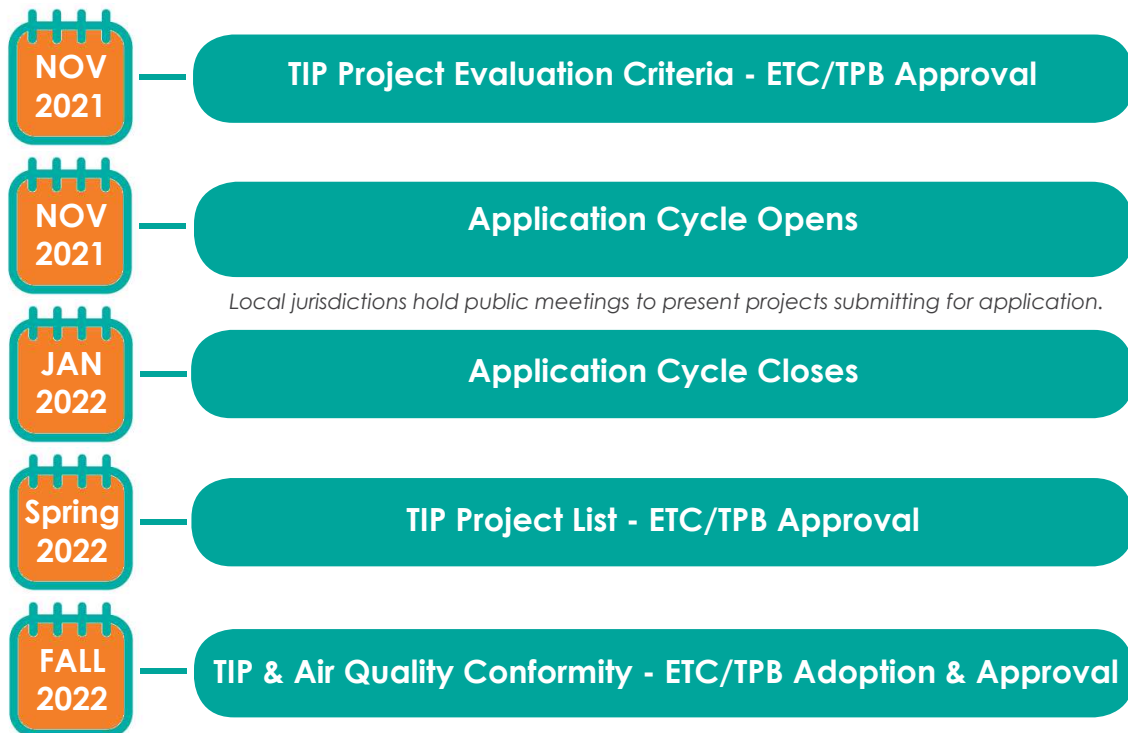
### What is the TIP?

The Transportation Improvement Program is a four-year, short-range program, which provides a prioritized list of federally funded multimodal transportation projects within the Memphis MPO Planning Area. The TIP is fiscally constrained and supports the vision of the Livability 2050 Regional Transportation Plan (RTP).

### Who is Involved?

The development of the TIP is 12-15 month process with coordination between local, regional, state, and federal agencies as well as the general public in Tennessee and Mississippi. Eligible project sponsors submit project applications for inclusion in the TIP. Projects are scored using the adopted criteria, aligning with the region's goals and priorities.

- Fiscal Constraint: 4-Year Period

- Public Participation & Involvement
- Consultation & Coordination
