The Memphis MPO has determined that the requested Adjustment #39 to the FY 2017-20 TIP meets the criteria to be processed as an administrative adjustment and not as an amendment. As a result, there was no public notice of the changes and no vote by the Transportation Policy Board to approve the changes.

TDOT has requested to adjust Shelby County's Air Quality Outreach Project, TIP# CMAQ-2008-02, by adding PIN #128034.00, which is a continuation of the current PIN #125428.00, associated with the project.

The changes are for an existing TIP project and there are no funding changes associated with the adjustment of this project. Since the TIP is a subset of the 2040 RTP then air quality conformity determination made on the RTP applies to the TIP (40 CFR 93.122).

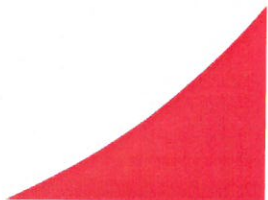

 The Shelby County Health Department will demonstrate the air quality benefits of improved public awareness through continuing the major public education and outreach campaign focused on clean air. The goal of this project is to educate the public, area leaders, educators, and businesses about connections among trip making and transportation alternatives, traffic congestion, and air quality. This campaign will help the Shelby County nonattainment and maintenance area reduce emissions and congestion by inducing drivers to change their transportation choices and reduce the number of single occupant vehicles from the road.
